### Labour's challenging tactics on Reserve Bank Amendment Bill.

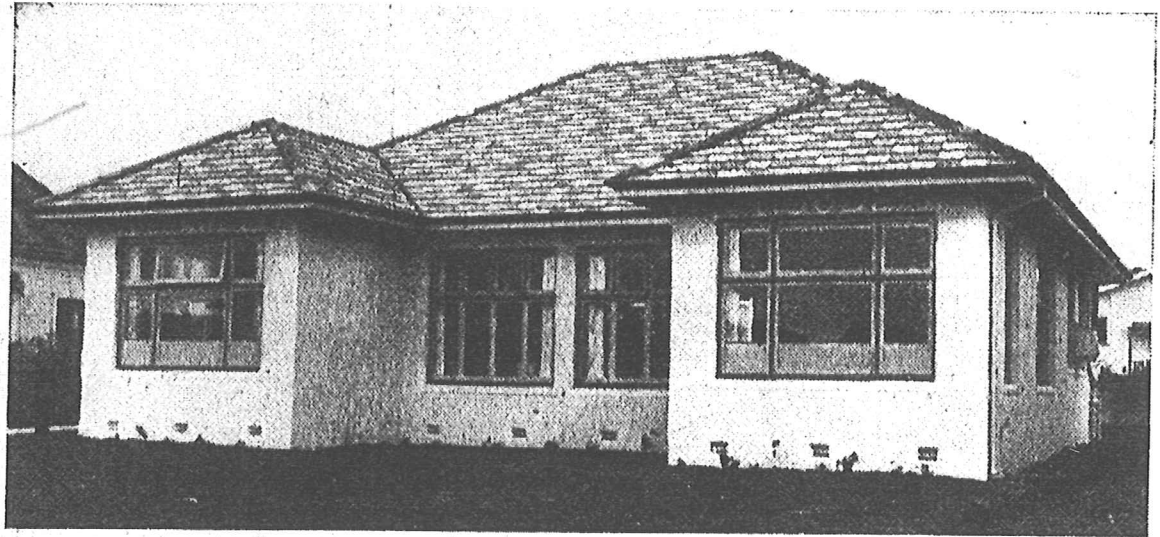

Wellington, Last Night.

THE House of Representatives spent the whole of this afternoon discussing a bill which had not been introduced at the tea adjournment. It is the Reserve Bank Amendment Bill, which the Prime Minister, Mr. S. G. Holland, said would remove the Reserve Bank from the direct control of the Finance Minister and would also provide for the establishment of a stable internal price level and stable purchasing power of money.

Adoption of challenging tactics by the Opposition from the outset meant that the bill, after a brief explanation by Mr. Holland, was discussed in detail with the house sitting in committee as a whole under the chairman of committees, Mr. C. G.
