

Borer in Old Church

The 92-year-old St. Bride's Church, which was removed in sections from its site on the corner of Barrett and Weston Roads to Broadmore Street, Vogeltown, New Plymouth, on Saturday, is infested in parts with borer.

The building controller has at present condemned the building but it is hoped to re-erect the framework and use the walling material that is not infested. The vestry of St. Mary's will hold a meeting to-morrow night and Wednesday night to decide what is to be done. Plans are at present in hand for remodelling part of the building. It is not thought that it is badly infested.
