

New Church Blessed At Toko

Of modern and attractive design, a new Roman Catholic Church, built at Toko for the Stratford Parish of the Church of the Immaculate Conception, was opened and blessed yesterday.

The church, which was opened by the Rev Father J. McGrath, Stratford parish priest, will be called St. Mary's.

It is the first Catholic church to be built at Toko. Masses were previously held in the Toko Hall, beside the new church.

Capable of seating 100 people, the brick, asbestos and concrete construction is 50 feet by 26 feet. It has varnished woodwork interior with glass partitions.

The construction of a similar church at Strathmore, 16 miles east of Toko, is well advanced.
