# Supermarket redevelopment

Residents are set to see a significant change in the old Woolworths store, located on the corner of Wallath Rd and Tukapa St, in New Plymouth.

The building will be demolished and rebuilt by its owners, the Foodstuffs Wellington Co-operative Society.

Property and retail development general manager Marty Price said: "Redevelopment of the site will kick off in September/October and we expect to be able to provide a brand new Westown New World by the end of 2013."

Mr Price said the new store would

have a total floor size of 2050 square metres.

It would have a trading area of 1320 square metres.

The market-leading design would have plenty of natural lighting via skylights, he said.

With an anticipated build time of 10 months, Foodstuffs expects to be advertising to fill both full and part time positions at the store by mid-2013.

"We would encourage anyone interested in working at the store to keep an eye out for the future job ads," Mr Price said.
