Start Next Month On T & G Block

Work on the T & G Mutual Society's proposed five-storey office block on the corner of Devon and Liardet Sts, New Plymouth, will begin as soon as the site is cleared early next month.

Approved modified plans and immediate construction of the building have been approved by the society's directors.

The cost is in excess of \$338,000.

Original plans were released last January, but since then detailed work has been done on architecture and proposed use of the building.

A four-faced clock tower will be erected on top of the block. The main entrance will be from Liardet St, leading into the main entrance lobby and lift foyer, with secondary access from the rear service lane and Courtenay St.

The society will occupy the ground and first floors and the balance of the building will be available to business concerns.

Five shops will be stepped up Devon and Liardet Sts, protected by a full-length stepped verandah. The completion for the block is estimated at July or August.

The architects are Stephenson and Turner, Wellington, and the contractor is Brough Construction Ltd, New Plymouth.
