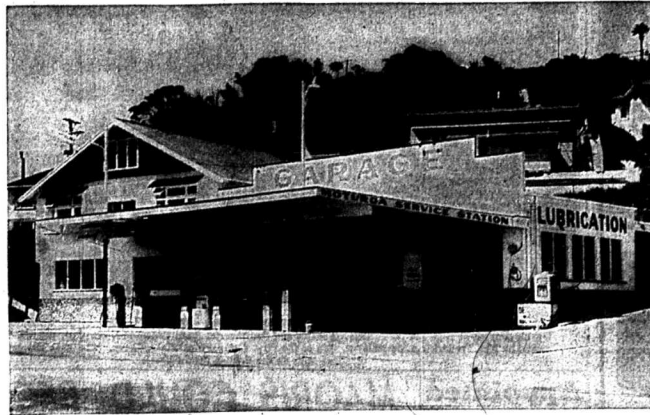

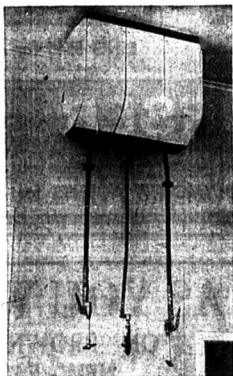

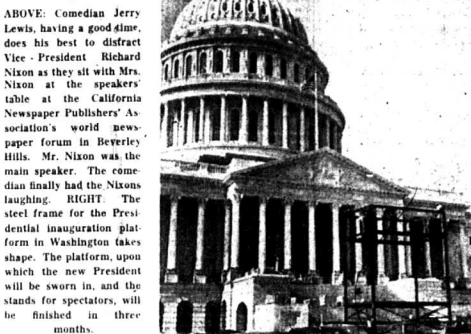

Rivals in non-stop drive for votes

NEW YORK, Wednesday. — The two rival candidates for the United States Presidency travelled widely today in a non-stop drive for votes, hammering away at the key issues of American prestige overseas and defence policies in the face of Communist power.

The Roman Catholicism of Senator John Kennedy, the Democratic aspirant for the White House also remained a strong question in the election to be held on November 8.

He and his Republican opponent, the U.S. Vice-President, Mr. Nixon, were both wading the waters of three important mid-western states — Ohio, Michigan and Illinois.

While the Republican candidate was rolling through the small towns and big cities of Ohio on the third day of his "middle-west" road-tour, his Democratic opponent was concentrating on the three industrial centres of Chicago and Detroit.

The pace of the campaign and schedule continued to give the campaign between the two with only 12 days remaining before the voters stream to the polls to choose the man who will occupy the White House for the next four years.

A disputed survey of how the passage of the United States appears

superseding the report and said its findings showed that Vice-President Nixon was uninformed when he claimed that the prestige of the United States now stood at a record high level.

“COMPLETELY WRONG”
Meanwhile Mr. Nixon, in Ohio attacked Senator Kennedy as being completely wrong in declaring that the present Republican Administration has tried to persuade Generalissimo Chiang Kai Shek and the Chinese Nationalists to withdraw from the tiny islands of Quemoy and Matsu off the Chinese mainland.

Senator Kennedy had challenged Mr. Nixon in the heat of their nationwide television debates to deny that this had been done.

The religious issue grew when a spokesman for a Masonic order which claims 50,000 members in 35 states confirmed reports that its leaders in a number of states had appealed to members not to vote for Senator Kennedy because of his religion.

Mr. Norman Stone of the Boston Hill Association declared there were no restrictions on the political activities of members outside the lodge and he knew of a number of states where letters urging opposition to the Democratic candidate had been sent out.

The Minneapolis Tribune reported that a Kennedy aide had warned his candidate that a survey in Minnesota and Iowa showed strong religious opposition to him from
