**AN ORDINANCE**

TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE FOR THE  
PROVINCE OF NEW PLYMOUTH.

**Analysis.**

Title.

Preamble.

1. Certain sums to be applied to the service of the Province for the quarter commencing 1st January, 1854.

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate Money to the Public Service for the Province of New Plymouth.

Whereas it is expedient to make provision for defraying the charge of the Provincial Government of the Province of New Plymouth for the period of three calendar months, commencing on the 1st day of January, 1854: And whereas the Superintendent of the said Province has recommended to the Provincial Council thereof to make provision for the specific services to which money is hereinafter appropriated.

Le it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of New Plymouth, with the Advice and Consent of the Provincial Council thereof:—

1. That for defraying the charge of the Provincial Government of the said Province, for the period of three calendar months, commencing on the 1st day of January, 1854, and ending on the 31st day of March, in the same year, there may be issued and applied out of the general revenue of the said Province for the several purposes and services, and at and after the annual rates specified in the schedule to this Ordinance, the sum of one thousand and four pounds one shilling and sixpence. Provided always that the several services specified in the said schedule under the head "Chargeable on Land Fund" shall not be provided for otherwise than out of the proceeds and profits of and attending the sale, letting, or other alienation of the Waste Lands of the Crown.

2. Grant for the present Quarter consolidated with the Grant for preceding quarter.

3. Treasurer to pay monies on Warrants of Superintendent.

2. That the Sums by an Ordinance of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of New Plymouth passed in this present session of the same Council, and numbered One (1) appropriated to the several services in the schedule to such Ordinance specified, shall severally be consolidated with the sums specified in the schedule to this present Ordinance, and therein appropriated to the same or the like services; and the aggregate amount thereof shall be applicable in like manner as if the same had been by this Ordinance appropriated and granted for defraying the charge of the aforesaid services (as specified in the schedule to this Ordinance) during the period of six calendar months, commencing on the 1st day of October, 1853.

3. That the Treasurer of the Province of New Plymouth shall issue from time to time any sum or sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore referred to, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively specified to such persons, and in such portions as the Superintendent of the said Province of New Plymouth shall by warrant direct; and such Treasurer shall in his accounts be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such warrants, and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums shall have been paid, shall be to him a full discharge of the sum or sums for which such receipts shall have been given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.

AN ORDINANCE to authorise the raising of a Loan for the Purchase of Native Lands within the Province of New Plymouth.

Whereas it is expedient to authorise the raising of a Loan to be applied in the purchase of Native Lands within the Province of New Plymouth.

Be it therefore enacted by the Superintendent of the Province of New Plymouth,

with the advice and consent of the Provincial Council thereof, as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the Superintendent to raise a Loan, not exceeding in amount the sum of £5000, upon the security of the General Revenue of the Province, to be applied in the purchase of Native Lands within the Province.

2. The Superintendent shall issue to the persons contributing to such Loan Debentures for the sums by them paid into the Treasury of the Province, in the form and to the effect prescribed in the Schedule to this Ordinance; and such sums shall bear interest, from the date of the Debentures securing the same, at the rate to be expressed in such debentures, not exceeding the rate of ten per centum per annum; and the principal money and interest secured by the said Debentures shall be charged upon the General Revenue of the Province; and all persons advancing money upon the security of the said Debentures shall be bound as well by the provisions of this Ordinance as by the terms and conditions in the same Debentures set forth.

3. Debentures issued under this Ordinance shall bear date as of the day on which the money thereby secured was actually paid to the Treasurer of the Province.

4. Debentures issued under this Ordinance shall have priority, and be discharged in the order of the dates thereof.

5. The Superintendent shall be at liberty at any time to discharge the principal money secured by any of the said debentures, or any part of the same principal money not being less than one-fourth part of the original amount thereof, on giving three calendar months previous notice of his intention so to do in the Government Gazette of the Province; and in the discharge of the said debentures he shall observe their order of priority.

6. No Debenture shall be issued under this Ordinance to secure a greater sum than £500 nor a less sum than £50.

7. All transfers of Debentures issued under this Ordinance shall be absolute, and shall pursue, as nearly as may be, the form prescribed in the Schedule to this Ordinance, and no transfer shall take effect until the same shall have been authenticated and registered in the office of the Treasurer of the Province.

8. Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall prejudice or affect the rights of the holders of Debentures issued by the General Government of the Colony nor any other

permanent charge upon the Revenue of the Colony heretofore imposed or authorised by any law or ordinance of the Colony.
