

SECOND WORLD WAR MEMORIAL FOR INGLEWOOD

There was a large attendance of residents of the Inglewood district on Sunday morning for the unveiling of a memorial plaque to fallen servicemen of the Second World War. The memorial is in the form of a flagpole with a small plaque at its base.

The Rev. Mr. Ashworth read the dedication service, and Mr. O. Grant recited Laurence Bunyon's poem "For the Fallen." The chairman of the Inglewood County Council, Mr. F. Laurence, performed the unveiling. The Inglewood Municipal Band and the Inglewood Volunteer Fire Brigade were in attendance.
